TRAVEL INFORMATION

Bassano is located in northern east Italy, one hour away from Venice, Vicenza and Padua, and easily reachable from Verona and Trento, too. It is equipped with a railway station and it is very well connected by bus too. We then encourage everyone attending the festival to pick the most sustainable travel option available!

By Train

the train station in Bassano del Grappa is located in the centre of the city. You can easily get to Padua, Venice or Vicenza, and then catch a "regionale" train to Bassano.

It is also possible to travel by bus from Vicenza to Bassano (approx. 1 hour taking the E05 bus): https://www.svt.vi.it/it/orari-percorsi/extraurbano

Note on accessibility: Trenitalia ask that you call in advance should you require assistance boarding their trains.

From VENICE "MARCO POLO" Airport to BASSANO DEL GRAPPA:

The Airport is connected to Venezia Mestre train station by a shuttle service.

To arrive to Venezia Mestre train station take the ATVO MESTRE EXPRESS. The bus stop is on the second lane outside the Airport Arrivals hall.

The journey will last about 17 minutes. / The cost is: 8€ (one way - 15€ for the round trip)

Once you are the train station, take the regionale (regional train) to Bassano del Grappa.

More or less there is a train every 30 minutes. Please, notice that during the weekend there is just one train per hour. To see the timetable, use the Italian Railways Site: https://www.trenitalia.com/en.html

From TREVISO "A. CANOVA" Airport to BASSANO DEL GRAPPA:

Treviso Canova Airport is connected by a bus service.

To arrive to the Treviso Centrale train station (Via Alcide De Gasperi), take the ACTT (line 6). The bus stop is in Via Noalese, to the right of the airport exit. Tickets are purchasable on the bus or in the MOM ticket office of the Airport near the arrivals area. The journey will last about 15 minutes.

Once you are in Treviso Centrale train station, take the *regionale* (regional train) to Bassano del Grappa. Once arrived at Castelfranco Veneto station you have to change train and take the train from Venezia Santa Lucia to Bassano del Grappa (the train ticket is the same: Treviso Centrale-Bassano del Grappa). From MILANO MALPENSA (MPX) airport to BASSANO DEL GRAPPA

Take the Malpensa Express to Milan Central Station. Tickets can be purchased at the trenord ticket offices in both Terminal 1 and Terminal 2. Trains depart every 30 minutes.

Travel time from the airport to Milan: about 51 minutes / Cost: ordinary €13
